Self-assessment of the quality of vocational education institutions for the 2022-2023 academic year.

Based on Circular No. 15/2021/TT- BLDTBXH dated December 15, 2021, of the Ministry of Labor, War Invalids and Social Affairs, which stipulates the Charter of - Colleges;

Based on Circular No. 28/2017/TT- BLDTBXH dated December 15, 2017, of the Minister of Labor, War Invalids and Social Affairs on regulations on the quality assurance system of vocational education institutions;

Based on Circular No. 15/2017/TT- BLDTBXH dated June 8, 2017, issued by the Minister of Labor, War Invalids and Social Affairs, promulgating the Circular stipulating criteria and standards for quality accreditation of vocational education;

In accordance with Official Letter No. 453/ TCGDNN-KĐCL dated March 25, 2019, from the General Department of Vocational Education and Training, regarding guidance on evaluating the quality assessment standards of vocational education institutions for secondary schools and colleges in 2019;

In implementing the program and plan for the 2022-2023 academic year, the Self-Assessment Council of Thai Binh Medical College has developed a self-assessment plan for the 2022-2023 academic year. Specifically, it is as follows:

1. Purpose and requirements

1.1. Purpose:

Raising awareness among faculty and staff throughout the university regarding the work of ensuring educational quality ;

Enhancing the capacity of key personnel involved in quality assurance work;

完善 mechanisms and institutions for building an internal quality assurance system for education within the school.

1.2. Requirements:

Quality assurance must be carried out regularly, continuously, and comprehensively in all management, training, scientific research, and other activities throughout the entire university;

Ensure the principle: All activities must be designed and implemented according to standard procedures. Build on strengths and address shortcomings from the 2021-2022 school year.

Conduct external evaluations of educational institutions and programs during the 2022-2023 school year.

2. Scope of self- assessment of the quality of vocational education institutions

Evaluate the school's operational areas according to the set of criteria and standards for vocational education quality accreditation as stipulated in Circular No. 15/2017/TT-BLDTBXH dated June 8, 2017, of the Ministry of Labor, War Invalids and Social Affairs, and according to Official Letter No. 453/2019/ BLDTBXH dated March 25, 2019 , on guiding the evaluation of quality accreditation standards for vocational education institutions, specifically for secondary and college-level schools .

- Regularly monitor, supervise, and evaluate results. Compile and report results within the specified timeframe.
