ORGANIZATIONAL PLAN

ARTS AND CULTURES COMPETITION TO CELEBRATE VIETNAMESE TEACHERS' DAY 20/11 "CDD - GOT TALENT 2022" AND AWARDING OUTSTANDING STUDENTS IN 2022

Implementing the 2022 activity plan, Thai Binh Medical College develops a plan to organize the student arts and cultures competition and award outstanding students in 2022, specifically as follows:

1. Purpose and Meaning

Launch and propagate the meaning of Vietnamese Teachers' Day 20/11.

Create a healthy and beneficial playground for students in the school, strengthening solidarity among school members.

2. Requirements

100% of classes participate.

Ensure educational, aesthetic, and safety aspects.

Ensure strict and serious organization, objective and accurate evaluation, selecting outstanding and high-quality performances to participate in the competition.



III. Program Content

1. Time and Venue

Implementation time: The program starts from 19:30 to 21:30 on November 16, 2022.

Venue: At the auditorium on the 7th floor of the 7-story building.

2. Content

2.1. Summary and Award Ceremony for Outstanding Student Competition 2022-2023 Academic Year

Summarize the outstanding student competition for the 2022-2023 academic year according to the school's plan.

Award prizes to students who won in the SVG competition for the 2022-2023 academic year.

2.2. Organization of the talent search competition "CDD - GOT TALENT"

2.2.1. Participants

Students of Thai Binh Medical College

2.2.2. Participation Format

Arts and culture performances include genres: solo singing, duet, group singing, dancing (folk, modern) with instrumental or vocal music, short plays, fashion shows, individual talents.

- The performances with required themes:

Praising love for the homeland, the country, the Party, and Uncle Ho; celebrating sovereignty over seas and islands, the homeland of cinnamon. Encouraging performances about childhood, school, teachers, folk songs, and traditional songs about Vietnamese Teachers' Day 20/11.

Each performance entry has a duration not exceeding 10 minutes.

Each faculty/major participates in 03 competition entries (each block within the major participates in 01 entry), specifically:

Nursing and Pharmacy majors each participate in 03 entries (each block within the major participates in 01 entry).

Laboratory Testing – Rehabilitation majors each participate in 03 entries (each block within the major participates in 01 entry).

Intermediate level participates in 01 entry.

Notes:

Encourage performances with accompanying dances.

Participants are responsible for preparing their own music.

The performance order for units in the competition will be determined by drawing lots by the Organizing Committee.

Performance costs for entries are prepared by the participating units.

2.2.3. Assessment

*** *Scoring method***

The score for a competition entry is the average score of all BGK members.

BGK scores must not differ by more than 2 points. If scores differ by more than 2 points, a re-evaluation of that entry is required to ensure fairness.

*** *Assessment method***

Scores are awarded on a 20-point scale for the entry and performance as follows:

Theme (5d)

Costume (5d)

Form, skills, performing arts (10d).

2.2.4. Prize Structure

01 First Prize valued at 1,000,000 VND (One million dong)

01 Second Prize valued at 500 000 VND (Five hundred thousand dong)



01 Second Prizes valued at 500,000 VND (Five hundred thousand dong),
03 Third Prizes valued at 300,000 VND each (Three hundred thousand dong)

3. Implementation Plan

3.1. QLĐT Department – Youth Union

Develop and implement the plan for students.

Receive and arrange competition entries.

Advise on the establishment of the judging panel.

Prepare contingencies.

3.2. Student Affairs Department

- Preside over the summing up and awarding prizes to excellent students.
- Coordinate with the Youth Union to organize the Artistic Performance Competition.

3.3. General Administration Department

- Prepare facilities and equipment for the Competition.
- Decorations, prepare the stage, loudspeakers.

3.4. Planning and Finance Department

- Guide relevant departments to make estimates, settle accounts for activities according to regulations.

This is the plan for organizing the Artistic Performance Competition, summing up the Excellent Student Competition to celebrate Vietnamese Teachers' Day November 20, proposing units to implement it.
