

## PLAN

### ORGANIZING THE 19TH EXCELLENT STUDENT COMPETITION, ACADEMIC YEAR 2023 - 2024

#### I/ PURPOSE, MEANING

- To create an enthusiastic atmosphere for learning and competition within the school, promote the movement of vocational skill training among students, contributing to honoring and promoting the image of Thai Binh College of Health students;
- To achieve accomplishments to celebrate the 93rd anniversary of the establishment of the Ho Chi Minh Communist Youth Union on March 26, 2024;
- To provide an opportunity for students to demonstrate their practical skills, approach, and familiarize themselves with the national vocational skill qualification framework and approximate Asean and World vocational skill standards; from which to select qualified candidates to join the school's team for training and preparation for the National Vocational Skills Competition.

#### II/ CONTENT

##### 1. Contestants and contest conditions:

###### 1.1. Contestants:

Third-year full-time students currently studying at the school, including: College of Nursing K14; College of Pharmacy K8, Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation K3

###### 1.2. Conditions for registration:

Students registering for the competition must meet the following criteria:

- Academic and training results for the academic year 2022-2023:
  - » Average GPA: achieve 'Good' or higher;
  - » Training ranking: 'Good' or higher;
- Not currently under disciplinary action;

##### 2. Content, format, time, and venue of the competition:

###### 2.1. Content and format of the competition:

Round 1: Students will participate in a comprehensive theoretical exam in the form of a multiple-choice test on computers.

## Round 2:

- **Number of contestants:** Select contestants for Round 2 based on the ranking from highest to lowest scores in Round 1, specifically as follows:
  - + **Nursing College Block K14:** 6 students
  - + **Pharmacy College Block K8:** 6 students
  - + **Physical Therapy & Rehabilitation College Block:** 6 students
- **Students will take a practical exam on direct situation handling according to the topics set by the Examination Board.**
- **The exam consists of 01 module related to medical, pharmaceutical, physical therapy, and rehabilitation fields (developed by departments and faculties and approved by the Examination Board).**
- **Duration:** Each module consists of 03 exam topics within 45 minutes (students have 15 minutes for preparation).
- **Total score:** 100 points.

## 2.2. Time, location:

- **Departments, faculties, and academic advisors create a list of participating students from February 19, 2024 to February 25, 2024;**
- **The Exam Committee develops the multiple-choice exam questions for Round 1 from February 22, 2024 to February 29, 2024; develops the situational exam questions for Round 2 from February 26, 2024 to March 03, 2024;**
- **Organize Round 1 exam on March 07-08, 2024;**
- **Organize revision for students for Round 2 from March 09, 2024 to March 24, 2024;**
- **Organize Round 2 exam on March 25 - 26, 2024;**
- **Exam location:** Medical and pharmaceutical practice rooms;
- **Summary & award ceremony:** 19h30' on March 26, 2024 (Tuesday);
- **Location:** Auditorium on the 7th floor - 7-story building;

## III/ AWARDS

### 1. Awards for students directly participating:

- \* **All contestants participating in the Competition:** Add 03 points to the training results of Semester II of the academic year 2023-2024;
- \* **All contestants participating in Round 2 of the Competition:** will receive a certificate of merit and a souvenir gift from the Organizing Committee;
- \* **Contestants with a Round 2 score  $\geq$  80 points:** will receive the title of "Excellent Student" at the school level and enjoy the following benefits:

- To be awarded a Certificate of Excellent Student at the school level;
- Add 05 points to the training results of Semester II of the academic year 2023-2024;
- Priority in considering Party sympathy, admitting to the Party;

**\* Awarded candidates:**

- > To be awarded a Certificate of Merit and prizes at the following levels:
  - **03 First Prizes:** for 03 candidates with the highest total scores in each major: 1,000,000 VND/prize; certificate cup.
  - **03 Second Prizes:** for 03 candidates with the second highest total scores: 800,000 VND/prize; certificate of merit.
  - **03 Third Prizes:** for 03 candidates with the third highest total scores: 700,000 VND/prize; certificate of merit.
- > Add 08 points to the training results of Semester II of the academic year 2023-2024; [Red Stamp]

Note: Academic advisors coordinate with homeroom teachers to implement the scoring based on the competition results and student achievements after the competition.

## IV/ IMPLEMENTATION ORGANIZATION

### 1. Plan Development:

Department of Training Management - Student Affairs coordinates with relevant departments to develop a plan ensuring the objectives and requirements of the competition, to be completed before February 20, 2024;

### 2. Establish Examination Council:

Department of Personnel and Organization coordinates with the Department of Training Management - Student Affairs to advise and issue a decision to establish the Excellent Student Examination Council, including: Organizing Committee, Examination Question Committee, Supervisory Committee, Secretariat of the competition before February 21, 2024;

### 3. Create List of Participating Students:

- Academic advisors of Nursing K14 classes coordinate with the Nursing Department to select and compile a list of eligible students to be sent to the Department of Basic Medical Sciences before **16:00 on February 23, 2024.**
- Academic advisors of Pharmacy K8 classes coordinate with the Department of Pharmaceutical Formulation, Medicinal Materials, Medicinal Chemistry and Pharmacology to select and compile a list of eligible students to be sent to the Faculty of Pharmacy before **16:00 on February 23, 2024.**
- Academic advisors of College of Physical Therapy & Rehabilitation classes coordinate to select and compile a list of eligible students to be sent to the Clinical Department before **16:00 on February 23, 2024.**

- Departments submit the list of students participating in Round 1 to the Department of Training Management – Student Affairs at 16:00 on February 25, 2024.

#### **4. Preparation of facilities and equipment for the competition:**

- Department of Basic Medicine, Department of Nursing, Department of Pharmacy coordinate with the Department of Administration to develop a plan for preparing competition venues in practical rooms, preparing facilities, equipment, and providing consumables to meet the requirements of the competition, to be completed before February 28, 2024;
- Department of Administration: provide adequate facilities, sound, lighting, and decorate the stage for the opening and closing ceremonies of the Competition. Contact, welcome, and arrange provisions for invited guests, develop a plan to ensure security and safety for the competition;
- Department of Planning - Finance coordinates with faculty departments, and advisory offices to prepare a budget estimate, consolidate payment of expenses after the competition concludes; Relevant departments submit budget requests to the Department of Planning - Finance before February 28, 2024;
- General Hospital develops a plan to ensure safety in epidemic prevention and control, takes charge of medical work, and healthcare for staff and contestants participating in the competition;

#### **5. Training and organizing the competition:**

- Department of Basic Medical Sciences, Department of Pharmacy, Department of Clinical Medicine coordinate with the Department of Training Management - Student Affairs to review and approve the list of participating contestants;
- Department of Inspection & Quality Control combines with the Department of Training Management - Student Affairs in organizing Round 1 of the competition.
- Department of Basic Medical Sciences, Department of Pharmacy, Department of Clinical Medicine coordinate with academic advisors to organize for students to familiarize themselves with equipment, competition layout, review for the exam, and participate in practical skill performance;
- Department of Training Management - Student Affairs coordinates with the Department of Administration to organize the competition ensuring its requirements are met;

#### **6. Communication and promotion for the competition:**

- Departments, offices, homeroom teachers, and academic advisors disseminate and popularize the competition plan to all staff and students of all classes in the school;
- The Communication department is responsible for communication, image promotion before, during, and after the competition;
